ALWAYS AND EVERYWHERE TO GIVE YOU THANKS

When we don't expect it, gratitude can be very confusing! When we do expect it and it isn't shown, we can be left feeling disappointed. There is a great awkwardness around gratitude and ingratitude.

In our Gospel this weekend all ten lepers experience healing they are thrilled and over the moon. Their lives have been restored to them. Only one we are told turns on his tracks and gives praise. There is no reason to suspect that the other nine were not appreciative of what Jesus done.

The word Eucharist means "thanks". When we gather at Mass, we do what Naaman and the Samaritan leper did: we give praise and thanks to God. We at every Mass hear the words "Always and Everywhere to Give You Thanks" The central prayer of the central act of the Church is always one of thanksgiving. Even in the most difficult situations it is always thanksgiving.

Christians are a Eucharistic people, which means we are thankful people. Often our prayers are about ourselves, asking for ourselves and others. This weekend is an opportunity to reflect on how much time we spend giving thanks to God and other people. In reflecting on the gospel we can also reflect on our own lives and ask why am I often reluctant to say "thank you"?
