HUMAN WEAKNESS AND GOD'S MERCY

Life is frequently described as a journey, what happens on the journey brings out the best in some people and the worst in others.

In his gospel and especially in chapter 18 – part of which we read at Mass this weekend – St Matthew offers advice to a Christian community that is divided and in need of reconciliation. It has to come to terms with the reality of scandal, be patient with sinful members who resist correction and be tolerant with those who seek to put limits on the mercy of God. Compassion is required with those who sin and have no intention of changing their ways or leaving the community.

In his assessment of the situation Matthew concludes that the basic problem is sin and the basic solution lies in God's unlimited mercy. That mercy has the capacity to heal. It gives the courage necessary to engage with current difficulties. On Calvery God forgave the inexcusable

This is the kind of ministry that every Christian is called to follow in our church struggling with the wounds of the past, the weaknesses of its members past and present. In his ministry Jesus acted out of a deep respect when he tried to correct sinners. He had strong words for some but always left an opportunity for change and repentance.

We have to learn to help and heal each other.
