## What is done Together!

The gospel of St Mark presents Jesus as a never-failing presence to ever failing disciples. From his many followers Jesus

chose twelve to be his – so to speak – inner circle of disciples. He called the twelve to grow in communion with himself and one another.

For the twelve the path to becoming a community of believers is chequered; it is marked by strides forward and many steps back. Generosity and service draw them together while competition for the first places caused division among them. They had quite different personalities. Peter was generous but could be impetuous. Thomas liked to ask the hard questions and articulate his doubts. James and John were passionate but fiery as well. They ask Jesus if he could call down fire from heaven on the inhospitable Samaritans.

Success is not final nor is failure fatal - it is their courage to continue that counts. Despite their many stops and starts the disciples did manage to persevere.

As they carried out their mission it is clear what is done together for the spread of the gospel is more effective than any lone ranger apostolate. What is being shared has more credibility when it is being lived.
