### The choices we make!

The choices we make give shape and direction to our lives. In the wilderness Jesus firmly rejected the temptations of Satan and confirmed the direction that his baptism had given to his life. Forty days of fasting and prayer strengthened him for the time of testing.

The desert was regarded as a place of danger, a space where the demons and wild beasts dwelt. When the Hebrews escaped from Egypt and found the wilderness very demanding they were tempted to go back to Egypt, to regress to avoid what was unpleasant. Jesus did not seek to escape from the wilderness and find refuge in circumstances that were less exacting. In prayer he reaffirmed that his life revolved around communion with his Father. All genuine prayer puts God at the centre. Prayer keeps priorities clear.

For all of us the price of freedom is constant vigilance. Good decisions expand that freedom, making the next good choice somewhat easier. Jesus points the way to follow if we wish to grow in inner freedom. It is through choosing God and through rejecting evil in all its forms. Good decisions further the kingdom of God. Poor decisions may further my kingdom, But not further God's kingdom.

'For Christians the challenge of a secularised society is simply this: to place God at the centre of life, to serve only him. That means swimming against a powerful tide.' There are two important lessons to be learned on our path through life. The first is that there is a God and the second is that I'm not he! Lent seeks to teach us those lessons.
