TIME APART IS IMPORTANT

Now that spring is here and the days are getting longer and brighter some people might like to take a walk in the countryside. We should be grateful that just a few minutes' drive can take us to our neighbouring parish of Ardmore from where we can park and walk in the fresh air of the countryside. If we are so inclined we can also climb to the top of some of the high areas there. The two things that are immediately noticeable in the countryside or a mountain, apart from a few sheep, are the silence and the panoramic view.

In the Gospel this weekend we are told that Jesus took the disciples up a high mountain. They did not have a car to get there, so it could have taken them some hours to get there. They probably spent the night on the mountain. It was a real and special experience for them to be apart by themselves. In fact Jesus took the disciples on a real retreat. The purpose of the retreat was to prepare them for what lay ahead. They were heading for Jerusalem where Jesus would be arrested and put to death.

The Transfiguration is a very real privileged experience for the disciples. Jesus gives them an insight into his relationship with God his father.

The disciples, Peter, James and John felt closer to Jesus after their experience together on the mountain. They would have liked to stay there, but they had to come back down and continue the journey to Jerusalem. Jesus still had a task ahead of him. The experience on the mountain helped to prepare the disciples for what lay ahead.

Our Sunday Mass, or indeed any Mass is like climbing the mountain. It is time apart, a special time in the presence of Jesus and receiving him into our lives. It prepares us to meet the challenges of the days ahead, knowing that we are not alone, Jesus is with us.
