For all of us there is the temptation to get to our final goal, heaven, with the least discomfort possible, even though the reality is that there is no easy way of cheap grace. Today's gospel is a challenge to think generously and stretch to wider horizons when it turns our focus to Jesus on Calvary as inspiration for living life to the full. In the gospel this weekend the generosity of God's love is a reason for great joy. God the Father sent his Son to bring healing, hope and meaning to life.

Love has its origin in God. Jesus is love in action. Love wants the best for others. This weekend the invitation is to look to Jesus crucified and what is behind the cross, namely the love of God. Jesus crucified offers salvation to all people and enables us to become more fully alive.

For the disciples the great icon of God's love is Christ crucified. It is testimony to the lengths God is prepared to go to convince us of the generosity of his love. He identifies with us and asks us to identify with him. To identify with Jesus, faith is required. It is only through the eyes of faith that we can see the significance of all that he has done for us.

This weekend let us reflect on God's love for me. We should frequently ask ourselves the question, do I really believe that God loves me, that I am unique to him? I am his work of art and that he died for me.
