Jesus was inspired by love in all that he did. When he instituted the Eucharist at the Last Supper he said to his disciples, "Do this in memory of me." What he asked them was to 'do this', do Eucharist, become Eucharist, live Eucharist, celebrate Eucharist.

We do many things in memory of people. Some have buildings or streets called after them, others are remembered by having their names inscribed in different places, others have their names linked to scholarship funds. Over the passage of time, despite our best efforts, memories fade.

Jesus did not want to be a yesterday memory. He gave us the Eucharist so that he might be a living presence that would never be forgotten.

Just as violence was about to be unleashed against him Jesus gave us the Eucharist. Love was his response to violence.

The God that we worship as revealed in Jesus is life and love. The desire of Jesus is that we become fully alive and radiate his love. The main fruit of the Eucharist is charity. In the Eucharist the Lord fills us with love for him, with love that reaches out to our brothers and sisters.

In reaching out to others we share the gifts we have been given and in different ways we become a source of blessing for others on their pilgrim journey.
